1. Enroll in Expree Cash \$tash. Email hello@expree.org to receive form or stop by the branch.

2. Each consumer debit card purchase tied to your checking account will round up to the nearest dollar and the difference will be transferred to the designated savings account. (Primary Share, Secondary Share, **Holiday Club or Vacation Club)**

3. All rounded amounts will be totalled each day and one transfer will be made at or near the end of each day.

- 4. If on any day, you do not have sufficient funds in your checking account, the transfer will not occur that day.
 - 5. There are no maximum amounts of purchases or change deposits per day/month.


