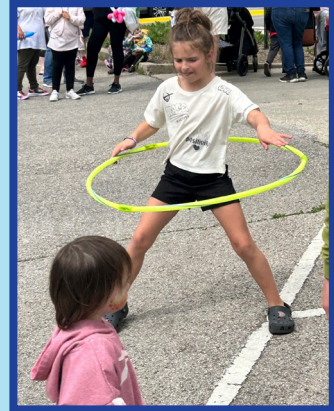

Expre enjoyed being able to partner with so many organizations and reach so many residents in our community. ●

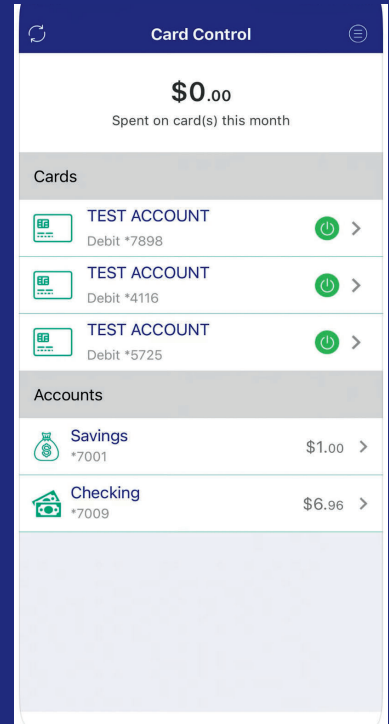
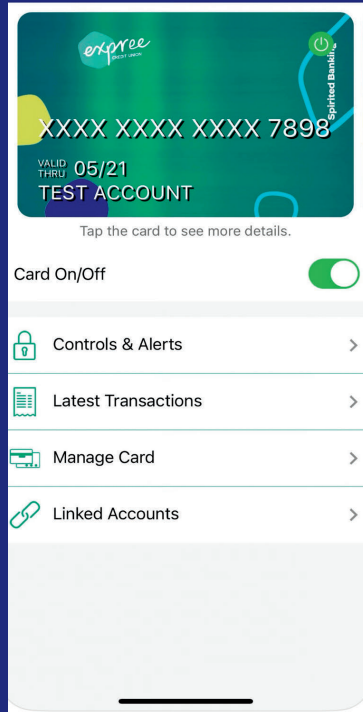
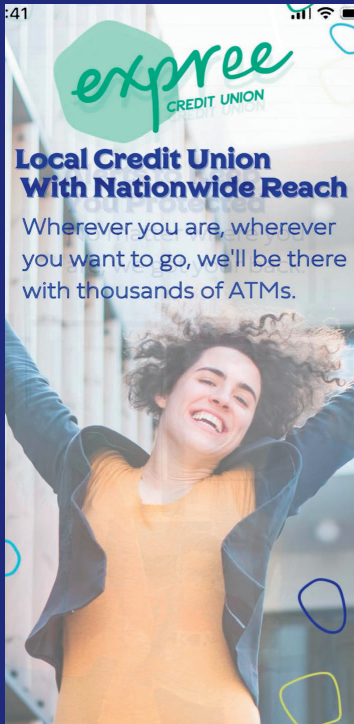
